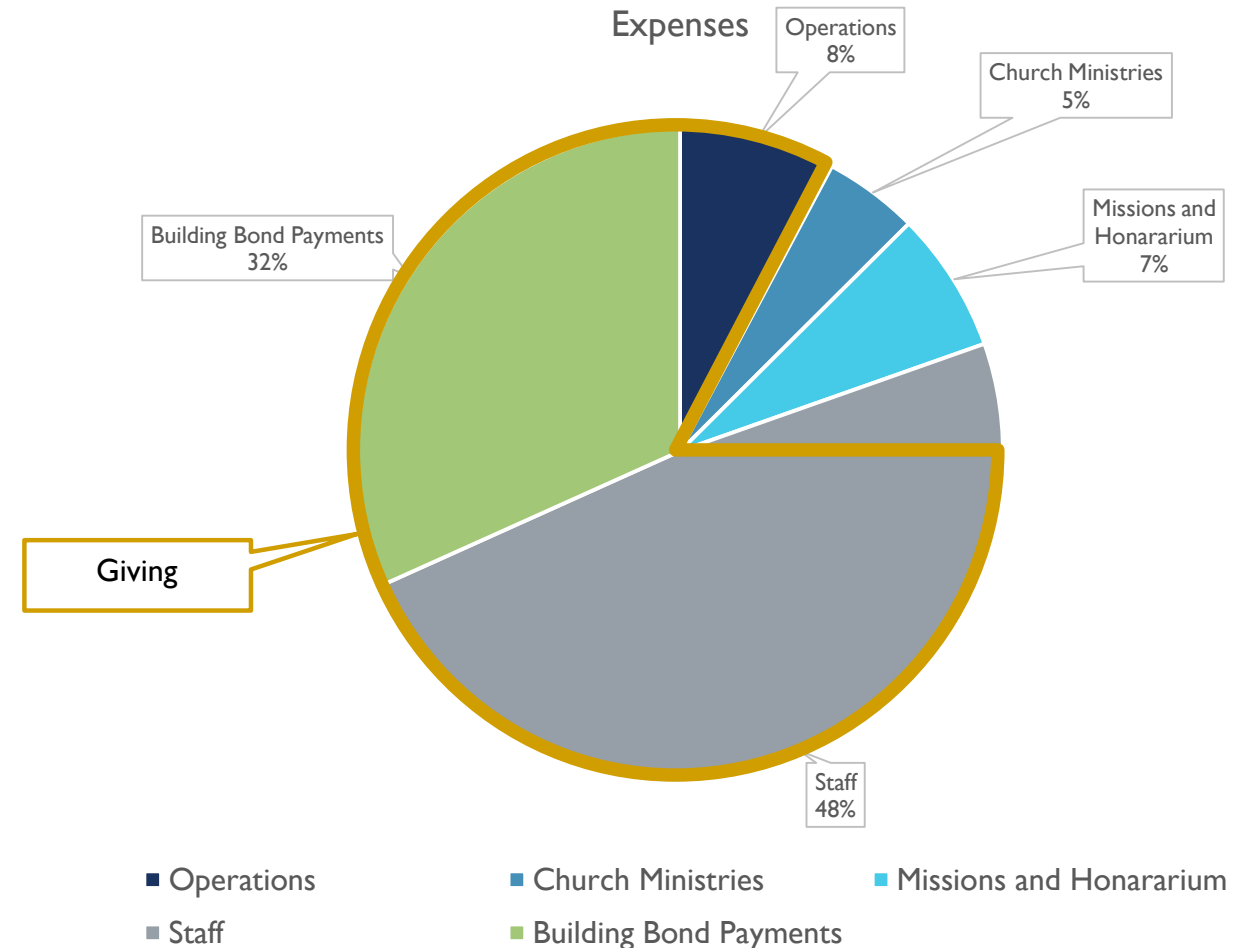

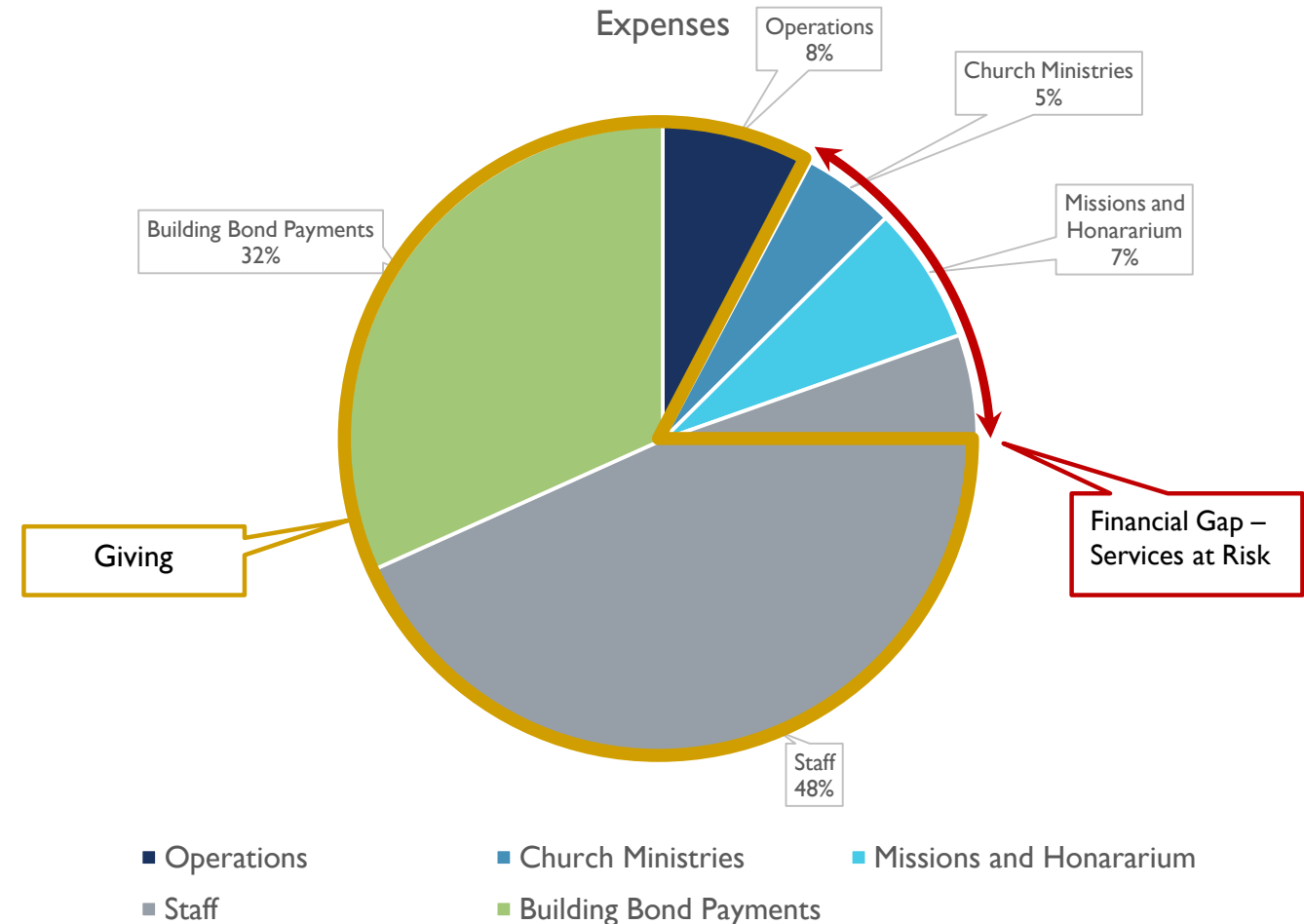

SUMMARY



- Reduced giving in past year resulted in expenses exceeding monthly income by an average of \$2500 per month
- Expenses have remained relatively neutral with the following exceptions:
 - Final increase in the bond payment started in Jan
 - Normal increases in fees and services for insurance, etc
- Solvent! We are still able to meet our commitments – Bonds, utilities, etc.
 - May require reductions in other areas – labor, ministries, and missions
 - Pray for God to send workers to the harvest
